Dear Parent/Guardian,

I hope this letter finds you all well.

I write to in relation to the new system of Behaviour Management we have begun to trial here in our school. Using our online system Vsware we are starting with 1st and 5th years and hope to roll out the system to all years going forward.

Each student will start off on 100 points, teachers can add both Positive and Negative points for behaviour, and students will gain or lose points as a result. Points can be gained for such things as: Excellent Homework, Civic Spirit, Courtesy, Manners, Team Work, Extra-curricular. Students can lose points for such things as: Truancy, Late for Class, Improper use of iPad, Detention, Lack of Class Materials.

When a student reaches 30 points she will receive a Well Done Card sent home and a small prize as well. We are going to have a competition amongst the two year groups to design their cards. This system will increase motivation in our students, it will give them a reason to succeed and excel, and research shows that it creates a positive environment in school's, students feel that they are being recognised for their efforts. All of the positive comments are achievable by all our students.
