Please note that Work Experience for all Transition Year Students will be each Wednesday for the upcoming Academic Year. Students are encouraged to complete a minimum of two different placements, to experience different work places.

Parents asked to pay the following monies on the online payment system before Friday 12th August. Any monies not paid collected in school on Tuesday morning, 30st August 2022.

In the interest of clarity and efficiency, the VSWare on-line payment system is the preferred method of payment. All payments made on-line are visible to the parent at any time which provides a better record of payments made. There are no bank charges and most of the fees paid by this method are at a reduced rate. TY Payments

The fee for Transition Year for 2022/2023 is €560, which includes TY Portfolio folder, Workshops, Trips and Activities. The fee also includes the four-day/three night Activity Trip, traditionally to Carlingford, Co. Louth.

As you can appreciate, the running of the TY Programme is a huge financial investment on behalf of the school and assisted by parental TY Fees. However due to the cost of Workshops and Trips away it is essential that fees are paid. If a financial issue exists regarding TY Fees and provision of a payment plan would help, please contact the school. Non-payment of fees may result in non-attendance on TY Trips such as the Carlingford Activity Trip.

The cost of Personal Accident 24 hour Insurance Cover will be covered by the school for this academic year.
