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In the interest of clarity and efficiency, the VSWare on-line payment system is the preferred method of payment. All payments made on-line are visible to the parent at any time which provides a better record of payments made. Some fees paid by this method are at a reduced rate with no bank charges. - From **28th August**, all students are expected to come prepared for all classes with iPads fully charged and all the necessary materials for classes.

Points to note:

- Students may only enter the school grounds through the **Grogan's Road entrance**.
- **Only Staff cars** are allowed on the premises between school hours, the site is small. Therefore, we ask parents/guardians not to drop students in the car park using the School Street entrance.
- If a student needs to leave the school during school hours:
 - 1) They must get **permission** from Tutor, Year Head, Deputy Principal or Principal.
 - 2) They must have a **note of explanation** on Vsware from parent/guardian (except when going home sick).
 - 3) They must **sign out** at General Office and sign in on return.
 - 4) They must be **collected by a family member at the office** or make suitable prior arrangement with school management.
 - 5) Students should never ring home themselves if they are sick. They must follow above procedures.
- Students arriving to school late must **sign the register** at the General Office; they will receive a Late Stamp in their journal.
- Students must report to the Deputy Principal's office if they arrive to school and are not in full uniform. Spare items of school uniform may be available for students should the need arise. Students not wearing the correct school uniform will not be allowed to attend class.

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

Students remain on the school grounds during lunchtime.

School Journal

Students must use the official Presentation School Journal. All students MUST always have their journal with them.

School Book Scheme

Schoolbooks are owned by the school; Parents & students should also take responsibility for ensuring that schoolbooks have a durable cover throughout the term of use by the student.

Schools are permitted to request a refundable deposit, which will be returned to parents/students when books are returned to the school in re-usable condition and in accordance with the school's

schoolbooks scheme policy. This is to incentivise students and parents to take care of books and to ensure the sustainability of the book scheme over time. This payment will be paid by all year groups once for the duration of their time in our school. It will be refunded once a student leaves the school, and books are returned in an acceptable state.

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Activities Fee

This fee helps the school to run curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities for our students.

It includes expenses like transport when representing the school at a variety of activities, sporting, non-sporting & leadership events throughout the country, affiliation fees to various organisations, breakfast club etc.

This contribution enables us to provide opportunities for students outside the classroom in many different areas to help the student experience.

Initiatives like the Meitheal Programme, where our 6th years support incoming first years, our 5th Year Peer Mentor Programme, where our 5th years support our 2nd year students are supported by this fund.

Lockers

Students Lockers allocated lockers during induction.

Personal Property

Students must take responsibility for their own belongings, iPads, jackets etc., making sure that all items are well labelled. Please make a special effort to label all items of uniform, including jacket and PE uniform. It is not advisable to bring other valuables into school, as the school will not be able to take responsibility for their safety.

iPad

Any parent/guardian who has a particular difficulty re the purchasing arrangements for iPads is asked to contact the principal before **24th June** on 053 91 24133.

Students/Parents/Guardians are asked, in so far as is possible, not to leave items at the General Office for collection by students – e.g. money, P.E. gear, Home Economics ingredients etc. Any items left at the General Office are left entirely at own risk & should be clearly labelled.
