- ✓ We marked outstanding academic performance of the Leaving Certificate Class of 2025.
- ✓ 6th, 5th, 3rd & 2nd year bonding was held recently.
- ✓ Fifth year Peer Mentors began their role on our return to school with a training session with Mr Grannell, followed by bonding activities and planning the year's activities
- ✓ First Year Information Evening.
- ✓ Our 3rd years have been enjoyed their trip to Emerald Park
- ✓ We rewarded excellent academic achievement in our school by awarding 20 students as Academic Scholars, based on their results in term tests & state

exams. To mark their achievements they received the 'Scoláire' badge, a certificate, & sponsored supervised study or a voucher

- ✓ Our 1st Year Sports Scholars & Sports Ambassadors received their PE uniform today which forms part of their scholarship pack.

Leaving Cert 2025

A report was made by Mr Ryan

- ✓ Results were very high, and our students performed beyond expectations.
- ✓ There was an increase overall in the number of our students on average scoring above 400- & 500-point marks. With 6 over the 600 points.
- ✓ Indeed, there were several students just 1 or 2 points shy of either the 400 mark or 500 marks.
- ✓ 65% scored over 400 points
- ✓ 40% over 500 points
- ✓ 80% or nearly 2/3 of our LC class scored above 300 points what an achievement considering the national average is 275, but more importantly what they experienced during their LC cycle.
- ✓ There were also many students with many additional needs, both emotionally, socially & other who performed above expectations and is a testament to the great work that all staff contribute each day here. Well done to those students but also to the staff who worked with these students on their 5/6-year journey.
